Key Stage 4 Humanities Trip to Paris: Tuesday, 23rd October to Friday, 26th October 2018

To complement the Key Stage 4 Curriculum in Geography and History, the Humanities Department is delighted to offer the opportunity for the current Year 10 pupils to experience first-hand importance and benefits of tourism and history in a vibrant European City

The tour will be organised by NST School Travel who specialises in educational visits in which they adhere to a rigorous code of practice and safety managements standards. We are proposing to visit many places linked with the Geography & History Curriculum. For example, The Montparnasse Tower, boat trip along the River Seine, visit to Notre Dame, Disneyland Paris and a shopping centre (all trips subject to availability of tickets). We will also visit Thiepval on the way to Paris and on the way back, call in at the Lochnagar Mine Crater. The trip includes transport (coach and ferry), full board accommodation and all excursions mentioned above

The cost and running of the trip is dependent on the number of students interested. We estimate that the trip will cost approximately £450.00, however this is subject to the confirmation of numbers. All money and reply slips need to be handed into student reception in an envelope with your child's name and form clearly labelled on the front. (If the Trip is oversubscribed, names will be drawn out of a hat). We will confirm whether your child has a place by Friday 23rd March, at which time payment plans will be instructed. A further meeting will be organised to explain the full itinerary.

NST insists that each child must hold a valid passport. The passport must be valid for the duration of the trip (please check the validity date as soon as possible). Please also ensure that the name shown on the passport matches the name on the reply slip below. Your child will also need a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). You do not need to pay for this card and should receive it within approximately a week following application. (Please be aware that some websites will ask for a payment for an EHIC card, however, you do not need to pay for this card.
