It is very important that you do collect these, as they are an official record of your examination performance. Future Employers, Colleges and Universities often require them as evidence. We advise you to please keep them safe as the cost to replace them is approximately £40 per certificate. For this reason, we are unable to post them to you.

We will only allow one person into the building at a time. **You must wear a mask and sanitise on entry to the building.**

If you are unable to collect your certificates, you will need to send your parent/carer with the signed attached letter along with ID.
