### **MATTERS ARISING**

- Funds requested by DT £220 for jam maker and mincer which was approved. Also contribution to costs of sports presentation evening requested from the PE department. Just need to go back to CJ for clarity on costs and how much will be covered by ticket sales – possibly donating £300.
- Wednesday 26th June from 6pm is Y7 intake evening, where we need to publicise the PTFA. Each child will be given an information pack – include a PTFA brochure showing where our funds have been spent, with photos.
- Recycling ink cartridges in school brings about 50 per branded cartridge. Look to set this up with drop off point in reception. Also batteries can be dealt with similarly.

### **FUTURE EVENTS**

- Proposed shopping trip to Meadowhall, Sheffield on 9<sup>th</sup> November. Coach will cost £375 for 48 seats, so tickets would be about £10. Will go ahead with this and publicise through the college and parish community nearer the date. In the event that not enough tickets are sold, we need to know how close to the date we can cancel the coach with Moving People.
- Indoor Ice Skating event – prices vary according to the size of the rink ordered. Would be around £10 per child for 45 minute session. It takes 5 hours to set up, is in use for 5 hours and takes 3 to 4 hours to dismantle. The company provides the skating surface, skates and staff. Issues with the idea are very late finish for staff securing school after the event, the expense of hiring the equipment and organising sales of tickets to ensure a good attendance. Tickets would have to be sold for each of the 5 sessions to ensure safe numbers of skaters for each session. Will look into cost of similar rollerblading event and ask for feedback from the student council.
- Hold a Quiz/bingo night with food and bar (an alternative to the fashion show but will still ask stall holders to attend) – for Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> October. Open doors at 6pm, quiz to start at 7.
- Provisional date for Spring Ball next year is now 1/3/14, as caterers unavailable on 8/3/14.
