### MATTERS ARISING

- **Spring Fair 8/5/13** – this event generated approximately £550 (a similar amount was raised two years ago at the fair which was hit by bad weather). Thanks to all involved for their support for the event. There were fewer students, families and staff attending this year, partly explained by the clash with the Keighley Cup final. The lady with the Ice-Cream van complimented the school on the good manners of the children she met. We discussed ideas for other fundraising and social events which might appeal more to the students. We will also ask the student council for ideas for future events, and possibly involve them in their organisation. Discussed band night, staff talent show, a cinema night at college and indoor ice-skating (JC to look for details). Could we target specific year groups for different events? E.g. A walking treasure hunt, for prospective Y6 pupils and parents, in the park or local area, followed by pie and peas in college. There used to be a long sponsored walk which was popular with students. The fashion show was discussed, with a possible change to its timing, as the most recent one was less well attended. Theatre trips for parents, and an out of town shopping trip by coach. (DF to investigate costs). Possible race night, at 110 Club.
- Went on to discuss Trinity Sunday and PT suggested holding future fairs at this time as part of celebrations for the feast of the Trinity.
- Requests for funds - £462 for BTRCC stick of rock for Trinity day. Also £300 for E. Fothergill who is taking part in the Catholic Games this year. £30 was spent on paint to refresh some of the games used at the Spring Fair.
