**Subject:** Changes to Break and Lunch Arrangements

Dear Parents/Carers, and Families

We are writing to inform you about an important change to our school day that will take effect from 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026. To enhance the experience for all students and make the most of our facilities, we will be moving to **one break and one lunch period**, with lunch lasting for **50 minutes**.

**Why are we making this change?**

This decision has been carefully considered to:

- Create a more consistent and structured timetable for learning.
- Reduce congestion and improve safety during social times.
- Ensure all students have equal access to facilities and opportunities.
- Make better use of our new resources, including the 3G pitch and expanded dining areas.

**What will this look like for students?**

We want to reassure you that this change has been planned with student wellbeing in mind:

- **Access to the new 3G pitch:** All pupils will have the opportunity to use our fantastic new pitch during lunchtime.\*
- **More extra-curricular clubs:** We will be expanding the range of lunchtime activities and clubs available to students.
- **Dining room rotation:** Pupils will follow a rotation system for when they eat in the dining hall and when they spend time outside, ensuring fairness and smooth flow.
- **Dedicated space for Year 7:** Year 7 students will have their own yard to help them feel comfortable and secure.
- **Additional serving points:** We are increasing the number of serving stations in the canteen to reduce waiting times and make the dining experience quicker and easier.
